

A WORD FROM THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR

By any measure, 2019 has been a dire year for small and growing businesses in East Africa. Most of them have had to walk the road less traveled, just to survive. Many have walked the plank into oblivion. From my numerous conversations with entrepreneurs (I can empathize - I am one of them) success this year for many has bottomed out to keeping the front door open. Never mind the limping!

That said, optimism is on the rise: In Kenya, the government started clearing outstanding debt obligations that had strangled business cashflows, with SMEs being most affected. Liquidity is also being boosted now that banks can effectively price their lending with the removal of interest rate caps that had curtailed commercial lending to small businesses for three long arduous years. The outlook for growth and job creation in 2020 is looking up.

At TBN East Africa, even with this myriad of challenges, we did not just strive. We thrived. We were able to raise USD 1.5M in investment for our entrepreneurs, with another USD 8M+ in the pipeline.



In Africa, 9 out of 10 jobs are created by Small and Growing Businesses. And these businesses contribute 70 percent to their country's GDP. And did you know that every dollar invested in SGBs generates USD 13 in the local economy? That's opportunity.




TBN COMMUNITY IMPACT
